Why Do I Get Vertigo?

You're rolling over to your right in bed, when suddenly the room starts to spin. For a few days, it continues each time you turn to the right. The condition, called **Benign Paraoxysmal Positional Vertigo** (BPPV), can be downright scary when it takes you by surprise. The dizziness, lightheadedness and nausea left in its wake will keep you from working and doing normal activities.

At the root of the problem are tiny calcium crystals that sense gravity, found within the chambers of the inner ear that can become loose and make you dizzy.



3 factors that affect ear crystals: being over age 65, having a

previous head injury, or viral inner ear infections.

You don't need expensive tests to get a diagnosis of BPPV! You can be diagnosed based on your pattern of symptoms and a medical evaluation. A vestibular physical therapist (PT) can show you how to do self-repositioning exercises to get the crystals back into place. All eight of our facilities have physical therapists that are highly trained in vestibular rehabilitation.

New to You: Telehealth Visits from Home

All WESTARM **outpatient facilities remain open** during normal business hours.
